 - **Two letters of recommendation** (at least one from a professor or teacher with whom you have studied) either sent electronically or in a sealed envelope directly from the recommender
 - **Essays** (typed and double-spaced) responding to the following prompts:
 - i. Describe a problem you've solved or a problem you'd like to solve – anything that is of personal importance, no matter the scale. Explain its significance to you and what steps you took or could be taken to identify a solution (500-700 words).*
 - ii. Why do you want to study Public Policy Leadership? In what ways do you believe a degree in PPL would enhance your contributions to society in the future?*
